Individual tests positive	 The Individual must follow the advice of NHS Test & Trace. This may include providing details of where they have been 48 hours before they developed symptoms or tested positive. If netball activity is involved in the list they provide to NHS test and trace, they may be required to provide contact details of the COVID-19 Officer. The individual should also notify the COVID-19 Officer of the positive test result so that they can prepare for a call from NHS Test & Trace. The risk mitigations and rule modifications have been designed so that netball activity should not fall within the NHS definition of close contact. The COVID-19 Officer should reflect how closesly risk mitigations and rule modifications were followed at the session the individual attended.
COVID-19 Officer may be contacted for details	 NHS Test & Trace may want to make contact with the COVID- 19 Officer. The COVID-19 Officer may then need to provide the contact details of any other members that were at the session and could have been in contact with the positive case. If competition, the COVID-19 Officer should also provide details to NHS of the oppositions COVID-19 Officer. The COVID-19 Officer, should notify the opposition COVID-19 Officer as well as the league COVID-19 Officer. If NHS Test & Trace do not contact the COVID-19 Officer and risk mitigations and rule modifications were followed at the session no further action is required by the COVID-19 officer. The COVID-19 Officer should not make decisions as to who should be self isolating. This is the role of the NHS
Notification	•If there are more than 2 positive cases of COVID-19 in any modified netball activity with in a 14 day period; the COVID-19 Officer should notify England Netball on Covid@Englandnetball.co.uk
